In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994" and Republic Act No. 7192, otherwise known as "An Act Promoting the Integration of Women as Full and Equal Partners of Men in Development, Nation Building and for other Purposes," and by virtue of CEB Resolution No. 034-211 approving the 2011 Budget for CHED Gender and Development, the Office of Student Services have opened two programs that will respond to **Gender Disparity** and on **Women Empowerment on Male Dominated Programs**, thus, the following rules and regulations shall be followed:

1. Screening of applicants and selection of grantees will be based on CHED Memorandum Order No. 29, s. 2009, "Revised Implementing Guidelines for the CHED Student Financial Assistance Programs (StuFAPs);
2. Awarding of **Full Merit Scholarship Program** hopes to address **Gender Disparity**. The qualified male applicants must enroll in Education or Computer Science programs, while, the qualified female applicants must enroll in Engineering or Computer Science programs.
3. Awarding of **Half Merit Scholarship Program** to **empower women** to enroll in male dominated programs. The applicant must enroll in any of the following identified programs:
  - Bachelor of Science in Information and Technology (BSIT)
  - Bachelor of Science in Computer Science (BSCS)
  - Bachelor of Science in Accountancy (BSA)
  - Bachelor of Science in Criminology (BSCriminology)
  - Bachelor of Marine Transportation (BSMT)

Attached hereto is the regional distribution of slots with corresponding award numbers, together with the basis of allocation.
