SUBJECT: XIII TRIENNIAL CONFERENCE OF THE INTERNATIONAL
ASSOCIATION OF UNIVERSITY PRESIDENTS

In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994" and by the virtue of Resolution No. 001, series of 1995, of the Commission en banc, Presidents of State and Private Universities are hereby informed, thus:

1. The International Association of University Presidents is scheduled to hold its XIII Triennial Conference in San Francisco, California from July 14-17, 1996.
2. The theme of this conference is "Linking the Universities of the World Through Telecommunications". The discussion will focus on communications, teaching learning assessment, international cooperation, peace education, accreditation and strategic planning.
3. A registration fee of \$575 will be charged IAUP members and a registration fee of \$875 will be charged non-members to cover a room reservation at Hyatt Regency Embarcadero Hotel and conference meals. Companions (spouses and significant others) will be charged a registration fee of \$300.
4. Enclosed are the conference calendar, the registration and payment form.

San Francisco Climate

San Francisco has a temperate marine climate year-round. Temperatures seldom rise above 70 degrees F (21 degrees C) or fall below 40 degrees F (5 degrees C). Morning and evening fogs are common during the summer months of June through August, but rarely persist throughout the day.

Wearing Apparel

Women are most comfortable in suits or pants or dresses with a jacket or a light coat. Men's attire requires only light to medium weight suits or sports clothes. An all-weather coat is recommended for cool evenings. Since the climate is mild year-round, lightweight summer clothes are seldom practical. Comfortable walking shoes are important as San Francisco is best explored on foot.

Of course, sports clothes and comfortable walking shoes are the proper attire for all pre and post tours.

Transportation Airport/Hotel

International visitors will find an Information Desk on the left immediately after passing through immigration, customs, and the exit door. Here you can choose your ground transportation, leaving from the lower level on which you arrive.

Taxi - \$29 to \$32 (Approximate, depending upon time of day/night as to traffic - ask before entering taxi.)

Limousine - Approximately \$15 per person sharing ride with others.

SFO Airporter - Take the Downtown Route to Hyatt Regency Embarcadero. \$9 per person one way/\$13 round trip. Frequency from SFO: 6:15 a.m. - 11:45 p.m. every 30 minutes.
