SUBJECT : MORATORIUM ON THE OPENING OF NEW COMMERCE AND
TEACHER-EDUCATION PROGRAMS IN ALL LEVELS



In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act (RA) No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994," and pending the issuance of updated guidelines rationalizing the offering of the subject courses, a moratorium is hereby declared on the opening of new commerce and/or business and/or accountancy, except majors in finance and/or entrepreneurship, and Elementary Education and Secondary Education, except majors in Mathematics and/or Science and/or English, programs, in the baccalaureate, master's and doctoral levels, effective 31 July 1996. Applications to open the said programs, however, filed on or before 30 July 1996 shall still be processed subject to the standards and procedures outlined in CHED Order No. 2, Series of 1995.


This CMO shall remain in force and effect until otherwise revoked.
