 In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act (RA) No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994," pursuant to Section VI. SUCs Eligible to be Participating Institutions and its Degree Programs under the SGP-PA of the CMO No. 22, s. 2012 entitled "Amendment to CMO No. 9, s. 2012 specifically Appendix 'C' entitled 'Guidelines on the Students Grants-in-Aid Program for Poverty Alleviation in the CHED Disbursement Acceleration Program,' and in view of Resolution No. 018-2013, the Commission **approved** the inclusion of the following SUCs authorized to accept SGP-PA beneficiaries, provided, however:

- That only the 1st year students who intend to enroll in CHED Priority Courses; and
