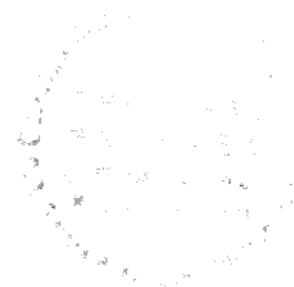

**SUBJECT : UPDATED LIST OF PRIVATE HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS (HEIs)  
GRANTED AUTONOMOUS AND DEREGULATED STATUS**

In accordance with the pertinent provision of Republic Act (RA) No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994," by virtue of Commission en banc Resolution Nos. **087-2012** and **148-2012**, and for the purpose of providing transitional mechanisms on key reforms aimed to rationalize the higher education system and thereby enhance its contribution to national development, the Commission hereby promulgates the following:

Section 1. Private Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) granted autonomous status in 2007 to 2009 and deregulated status in 2009 and 2010 shall retain their respective status until **31 May 2014** by virtue of CHED Memorandum Order (CMO) No. 10, s. 2012, otherwise known as the "Extension of the grant of autonomous and deregulated status to existing autonomous and deregulated HEIs and Evaluation of pending applications for 1) the grant of autonomous and deregulated status; and 2) upgrading of autonomous from deregulated status."

HEIs that have extended autonomous and deregulated status shall enjoy all the benefits as specified in Articles VI and VII of CMO No. 44, s. 2008, except for Sections 32 and 33 of Article VI, which provide autonomous HEIs the privilege *to 1) establish branch (es) or satellite campus (es) and 2) offer extension classes to expand access to higher education*. However, beyond their original validity period, autonomous HEIs that wish to establish branches or satellite campuses and to offer extension classes will be required to secure government authority from CHED.


Section 3. Any and all CHED issuances, which are contrary to or inconsistent with any of the provisions herein, are hereby deemed repealed or modified accordingly.
