1. The Girl Scouts of the Philippines, a member of the World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts has the mission to enable girls and young women ages-4-21 years old, realize the ideals of womanhood and prepare themselves for their responsibilities in the home, the nation and the World Community.
2. The Commission on Higher Education recognizes the Girl Scout Movement and believes that involvement of students in higher education institutions in Girl Scout programs/projects will make them more dynamic, progressive, proactive, patriotic and God-loving.
3. In this regard, higher education institutions, public and private are enjoined to encourage every student to become a member of the Girl Scouts of the Philippines organize them into troops and participate in their training programs/activities to update their knowledge and skills in Girl Scouting. Remittance of registration fee of twenty-five (P25.00) pesos per student should be forwarded to the respective Girl Scout Council Office in every province/city.
4. In order to effectively carry out the Girl Scout Program, troop leaders and other adult volunteers should exercise and impart the GSP Program called the Eight (8) Point Challenge namely: Challenge of Well-Being, Arts, Economic Self-Sufficiency, Environment, Preparedness, Culture and Heritage, Family Life and World Community, which provides ample opportunities for the total development of the girls.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
