**SUBJECT: REVISIONS/ADDENDA IN CHED ORDER NO. 01 SERIES OF 1999 "RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR CHED SPECIAL STUDY GRANT PROGRAM FOR CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS"**

For clarification and uniformity in the interpretation of the provisions of CHED Order No. 01 Series of 1999 entitled "Rules and Regulations for CHED Special Study Grant Program for Congressional Districts", the following revisions/addenda are hereby adopted and promulgated by the Commission in the specific Sections, thus:

**III. Coverage**

This special study grant shall be opened to poor but deserving college qualifiers from the 240 Congressional Districts of the country to enroll in a course and in any curriculum year levels preferably in public HEIs-SUCs and CHED Supervised Institutions (CSIs).

**VIII. Financial Privileges**

1. Each grantee is allotted a maximum P5,000.00 per year to cover the following benefits

Tuition and other school fees - - - -	P 1,000 x 2 sem. = P 2,000
Monthly Living allowances - - - -	300 x 10 mo. = 3,000
<b>Total</b>	<b>P 5,000</b>


Any excess amount from the P 1,000.00 per semester allocation for tuition and other school fees shall be given to the student-beneficiary.

**Tuition and other school fees charged by the school in excess of the allotted financial benefits shall be shouldered by the student-beneficiary.**
