CODES FOR HIGHER EDUCATION  
PROGRAM CLASSIFICATION, STATISTICAL  
AGGREGATION AND ADOPTION FOR SPECIAL  
ORDER CODES FOR PRIVATE HIGHER  
EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS EFFECTIVE  
ACADEMIC YEAR 1998-1999

In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994," and by virtue of Resolution No. 001, series of 1995 of the Commission en banc, all concerned, i.e. Presidents and/or Heads of all Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) in the country and Regional Directors of the Commission's Higher Education Regional Offices (HEROs), are hereby directed and/or enjoined, thus:

1. The Discipline Codes, Appendix III of the CHED Data Element Manual No. 96-1 as revised (revised August 1997) shall be adopted for classifying higher education programs of higher education institutions (HEIs) in the country.
2. The Discipline Codes shall also be used for aggregation of higher education data to ensure uniformity and comparability of education statistics in the country at par with the statistics of the UN member countries.
3. The Discipline Codes shall likewise be adopted as codes for the issuance of Special Order (S.O.) for higher education programs of private higher education institutions.

The implementation of the Discipline Codes is in accordance with the National Statistical Coordination Board (NSCB) Memorandum Circular No.01-98 enjoining all concerned agencies to adopt the Updated Philippine Standard Classification of Education (PSCED).

The PSCED was based on the UNESCO International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED) which, was revised, updated and adopted for classifying Philippine programs in coordination with NSCB, DECS and TESDA. However, due to the numerous program codes listed in the PSCED, only codes for higher education was captured and included in the CHED Data Element Manual No.96-1 as Appendix III

(Discipline Codes). Further consultations with the NSCB ensued to add codes for new higher education programs, hence, the Revised Discipline Codes (revised August 1997).

Previous issuances inconsistent with the Revised Discipline Codes are deemed revised and/or superseded accordingly.

This CMO takes effect on the first semester of Academic Year 1998-1999.

## INTRODUCTION TO DISCIPLINE CODES

Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) offer programs in various fields of study or disciplines. Many of the disciplines offered by HEIs may seem very closely related. For instance, it may seem very natural to group the following together: Business Management, Business Administration, Commerce, etc. The question is: if all the disciplines represented by the various programs offered by the HEIs were grouped together into a manageable number, how many major groups would there be? What would be the disciplinary groupings? How should these be coded for the computer environment?

This appendix shows the first attempt of CHED to group the various program offerings of Philippine HEIs into a few disciplinary groups. There are nineteen (19) major disciplinary groups as follows:

1. GENERAL
2. EDUCATION AND TEACHER TRAINING
3. FINE AND APPLIED ARTS
4. HUMANITIES
5. RELIGION AND THEOLOGY
6. SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE
7. BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION AND RELATED
8. LAW AND JURISPRUDENCE
9. NATURAL SCIENCE
10. MATHEMATICS AND COMPUTER SCIENCE
11. MEDICAL AND ALLIED
12. TRADE, CRAFT AND INDUSTRIAL
13. ENGINEERING
14. ARCHITECTURAL AND TOWN-PLANNING
15. AGRICULTURAL, FORESTRY, FISHERIES AND VETERINARY MEDICINE
16. HOME ECONOMICS
17. SERVICE TRADES
18. MASS COMMUNICATION AND DOCUMENTATION
19. OTHER DISCIPLINES

There is nothing sacred about the number 19 nor is there anything sacred about the choice of major disciplinary groupings above. However, for HEMIS purposes, decisions had to be made. The classification above was decided by CHED in conjunction with the National Statistics Coordinating Board (NSCB) which in turn based its classification on a UNESCO system. For the purpose of HEMIS, all curricular programs in Philippine HEIs will have to be classified into one of the 19 major headings above. Within a major heading or major disciplinary group, e.g. SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE PROGRAMS, there are a number of subdisciplines. The list of subdisciplines or sub-

subdisciplines may be found in the following pages. This will guide people in determining where a particular curricular program should be classified.

For example, to find the "Discipline Code" of the field "Hotel and Restaurant Management", one should look under the 7th group, "BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION AND RELATED". Under this major group, there is a subgroup titled "INSTITUTIONAL ADMINISTRATION/MANAGEMENT" (page 7) and within this subgroup is to be found the sub-subdiscipline "Hotel and Restaurant Management". The prescribed code is 346201. (Note: the code is a 6-digit numeric block). Thus all curricular programs in "Hotel and Restaurant Management" -- whether they are at the pre-baccalaureate, baccalaureate, masters or doctoral level --- should all be classified under the discipline code 346201.

Elementary education programs should all be coded as 001001- Elementary Basic Knowledge.

Secondary education programs should all be coded as 001002 - Secondary Basic Knowledge.

All Voc-Tech education programs should be coded 520000.

PURPOSE

Two programs such as AB History and BS Math are obviously different but most people will say they belong to the same "level" because they are both baccalaureate programs. This element captures the level of a program in some sort of hierarchy of programs.

DESCRIPTION

This element will indicate the program level expressed as a 2-digit numeric code.

**PURPOSE**

Some programs fall naturally together into the same discipline or field of study. For instance, all programs in Biology, Geology, Physics, Chemistry, etc. -- whether they are at the BS, MS or PhD levels -- may be said to fall together under the discipline of "Natural Sciences". On the other hand programs in Business Administration, Management, Commerce, Accounting, Finance, etc. -- fields which are not identical but are related anyway -- may be said to be in the discipline of "Business Administration". This element will be used to group programs into clusters of disciplines to facilitate national manpower planning.

**DESCRIPTION**

The major discipline of a program. This element is not meant to distinguish between AB History and MA History -- which are of different levels but belong to the same discipline "History" or "Social Sciences". This element is not meant to distinguish either between Bachelor of Arts in Psychology and Bachelor of Science in Psychology. Although the distinction between an AB and a BS is important within an institution, it is deemed not to be important enough for discipline classification at the national level. Thus, both will be put under "Psychology" or "Social Sciences".
