ANNOUNCEMENT

The Commission on Higher Education (CHED) through the Office of Policy, Planning, Research and Information - Research Division (OPPRI-RD) is now accepting Research Proposals from all Higher Education Institutions in the Country.

Grants are available on the following scheme:

- **Block Grants**

Block Grants are available on a competitive basis and are awarded to all public and private higher education institutions with proven track record in research, with at least 5% of faculty force are holders of Ph.D. degrees, and with an existing research center or unit updated with computing facilities and research journals.

- **Grants-In-Aid**

Grants-In-Aid are awarded to public and private Higher Education which demonstrate a potential for research. It aims primarily to encourage research undertaking among developing HEIs.

- **Commissioned Research**

Commissioned Research are awarded to either an individual or an institution with proven track record in research and has demonstrated leadership in the scientific and academic community.

- **Grants for Research Professorial Chairs**

Grants for Professorial Chairs are awarded to outstanding research professors who are nominated by a private or public HEI and who are actively engaged in research.
