

In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act (RA) No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994," pursuant to Section VI. SUCs Eligible to be Participating Institutions and its Degree Programs under the SGP-PA of the CMO No. 22, s. 2012 entitled "Amendment to CMO No. 9, s. 2012 specifically Appendix 'C' entitled 'Guidelines on the Students Grants-in-Aid Program for Poverty Alleviation in the CHED Disbursement Acceleration Program,' and in view of Resolution No. 469-2012, the Commission **approved** the acceptance of grantees for AY 2012-2013 under the SGP-PA by the following Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) in CHEDRO-IVB and CARAGA:

1. MINS CAT - only the 1st year students who intend to enroll in BS Agriculture and Teacher Education will be allowed to be program beneficiaries of SGP-PA; and
2. CSU - only the 1st year students who intend to enroll in Elementary and Secondary Teacher Education programs are allowed to be program-beneficiaries of SGP-PA
