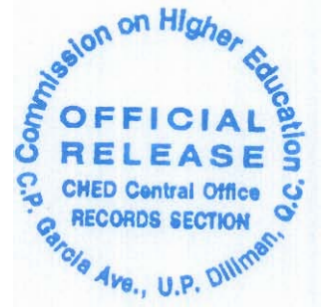

SUBJECT : AMENDMENT TO FINANCIAL BENEFITS OF CMO NO. 19, SERIES OF 2013 "IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR THE SAJAHATRA BANGSAMORO STUDY GRANT PROGRAM (SBSGP)"

In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994", CMO No. 19, series of 2013 "Implementing Guidelines for the Sajahatra Bangsamoro Study Grant Program (SBSGP)" and by virtue of Commission en Banc Resolution No. 269-2015 dated May 25, 2015, this Commission hereby amends the provision of Item V of CMO No. 19, Series of 2013 to read as:

"II. Coverage

The program is open to identified deserving Bangsamoro beneficiaries who have limited access to opportunities to study in college. A total of one thousand ninety four (1,094) slots (including the six hundred thirty nine (639) existing slots) will be allocated effective AY 2015-2016.

V. Financial Benefits

Each grantee is allotted a maximum of Php10,000.00 per semester or Php20,000.00 per academic year to cover tuition, other school fees, textbook/other learning materials and stipend effective AY 2015-2016."

All other clause/provisions of CMO No. 19, Series of 2013 not affected by this amendment shall remain valid and enforceable.
