SUBJECT : ZONAL ORIENTATION ON CMO NO. 104, S. 2017 ENTITLED "REVISED GUIDELINES FOR STUDENT

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM IN THE PHILIPPINES (SIPP) FOR ALL PROGRAMS" FOR REGIONS VI, VII

AND VIII ONLY

DATE : MARCH 22, 2018

Pursuant to the pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 7722 otherwise known as the Higher Education Act of 1994", the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) through the Office of Student Development and Services (OSDS) will conduct an Orientation on the "Revised Guidelines for Student Internship Program in the Philippines (SIPP) for All Programs", to be held on May 24, 2018 at Iloilo City starting 9:00 a.m. (exact venue to follow).

The objective of the orientation is to discuss and update the CHED Regional Office (CHEDRO) Directors and/or Coordinators and selected Heads and/or SIPP Coordinators from identified higher education institutions (HEIs) per region on the information and specific provisions in the revised guidelines. CHED Regional Offices shall submit to OSDS:

- not more than fifty seven (57) participants (3 CHEDRO representatives and 54 Heads and/or SIPP Coordinators & Student Leader of HEIs) for CHEDRO VI only; and
- not more than thirty (30) participants (1 CHEDRO representative and Heads and/or SIPP Coordinators & Student Leader of HEIs) each for Regions VII and VIII

on or before May 15, 2018. Number of participants per regions shall be strictly observed due to financial constraints. The list of participants received beyond the said period may not be accommodated. Copy of the "Revised Guidelines for Student Internship Program in the Philippines (SIPP) for All Programs" shall be made available at www.ched.gov.ph.

Registration is free. However, travel expenses incurred in this activity shall be charged against local/regional funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Expected participants from the HEIs shall make an arrangement with their respective School Heads. Further, CHED-OSDS will provide accommodation to CHEDRO representatives only.

Confirmations of attending participants from the HEIs shall be done by the CHEDROs and that said confirmation must be communicated to the Office of Student Development and Services (OSDS).
