**SUBJECT : AMENDMENT TO JMC NO. 04, SERIES OF 2019 ENTITLED  
"REVISED IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES OF THE CHED-  
TULONG DUNONG PROGRAM (CHED-TDP)"**

In the implementation of the Joint Memorandum Circular No. 04, series of 2019 entitled "Revised Implementing Guidelines of the CHED-Tulong Dunong Program (CHED-TDP) pursuant to Special Provision No. 4 of TDP under RA No. 11260, the GAA for FY 2019, and by virtue of Commission en banc (CEB) Resolution No. 588-2019 dated 17 September 2019, the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) recognized the urgent need to modify some of the provisions to ensure that the appropriations are properly administered and implemented according to its purpose.

Section 4. Coverage of JMC 04-2019 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The CHED-TDP is intended for the new grantees who are enrolled or will enroll in any curriculum year level in CHED-recognized programs of Private Higher Education Institutions (Private HEIs), or authorized programs of State Universities and Colleges (SUCs)/Local Universities and Colleges (LUCs).

Accordingly, all other provisions of the JMC with Certificate of Program Compliance (COPC) in reference to the programs offered by SUCs/LUCs are hereby modified as "authorized programs".

All other provisions of JMC No. 4, series of 2019 not affected by this amendment shall remain valid and enforceable.
