CALL FOR RESEARCH PRESENTATIONS

Guidelines in the Online Research Presentation for the 2021 Research Forum on Drug Abuse Prevention and Control

The 2021 Research Forum on Drug Abuse Prevention and Control of the Dangerous Drugs Board provides an avenue for cooperative research and exchange of scientific information in the field of drug supply and drug demand reduction. The call for online research presentation is open to all government agencies, public and private academic institutions, non-government organizations, and socio-civic groups.

The mechanics for each of the following activities are as follows:

A. ORAL RESEARCH PRESENTATION

1. Proponents of the qualified research project will present their study as part of the monthly featured research presentation on drug abuse prevention and control.
2. The Policy Studies, Research, and Statistics Division of the Dangerous Drugs Board shall review and evaluate the participating entities' entries. Content and Methodology experts will compose the technical review and evaluation of the entries.
3. For the screening process, interested applicants must submit through email the completed paper attached with an abstract to the Policy Studies, Research, and Statistics Division to:

4. One (1) completed research will be selected monthly for an oral research presentation. The selection of the research projects will be based on the following criteria:
 - a. Research should be on the field of drug abuse prevention and control preferably completed within the last five (5) years
 - b. Research should be technically and ethically sound
 - c. Research provides solutions/recommendations on the drug problem
 - d. Research provides new insights leading to significant drug abuse prevention and control policy recommendations.
 - e. Research outcome could contribute to the Dangerous Drugs Board priorities and outcomes in line with the Philippine Anti-illegal Drugs Strategy.

5. Research should also include the following details:
 - a. Research title
 - b. Date of Completion and Duration of the research
 - c. Author/Proponent
 - d. Research Description
 - e. Research Objectives
 - f. Research Scope and limitations
 - g. Research methodologies (research method used, sampling technique, population and sample size, research instrument, statistical techniques used)
6. The oral research presentation in the research forum will utilize an online form of discussion. The link will be provided to qualified research presenter who will be in the featured research for the month.
7. Presented research projects will also be included in the publication of the DDB Research Journal.

B. POSTER EXHIBIT PRESENTATION

1. Qualified research projects will also be included in the poster exhibit presentations of the research forum tentatively scheduled on 24 September 2021.
2. The poster exhibit presentation should include the following information:
 - a. Title of the research/project
 - b. Author or Proponent of the research/project
 - c. Contact details of the Author or Proponent
 - d. Research Description and Rationale
 - e. Research Objectives
 - f. Research Scope and Limitations
 - g. Research methodologies (research method used, sampling technique, population and sample size, research instrument, statistical techniques used)
 - h. Abstract
3. One poster panel with size (2Ft by 4Ft) will be allowed for entry.
4. Graphical and other visual presentations may be included.
5. Participants are expected to present their research utilizing blended (physical and online) discussion forms in the research forum.
6. Presented research projects will also be included in the publication of the DDB Research Journal.



C. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

1. Technical Criteria (30%)
2. Presentation of the Research (35%)
3. Alignment and relevance of the research output on the field of drug abuse prevention and control. (15%)
4. The potential contribution of the research on the priorities and policies on drug demand and drug supply reduction. (25%)

D. AWARDS / INCENTIVES

Qualified research will be presented in the monthly featured research presentations on drug abuse prevention and control.

The presented research will also be included in the publication of the Dangerous Drugs Board research journal and will be featured in the DDB Research Bulletin.

The presenters on the monthly featured research presentations will also receive an honorarium and a certificate of recognition from the Dangerous Drugs Board.
