SUBJECT : ADDITIONAL ALLIED HEALTH PROGRAMS FOR LIMITED FACE-TO-FACE CLASSES

Pursuant to the Memorandum from the Executive Secretary dated January 11, 2021 with the subject, *Resumption of Limited Face-to-face Classes for Medical and Allied Health-Related Programs of Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) in Areas under Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ) and of HEIs in General Community Quarantine (GCQ) Areas with Base Hospitals that Cater to COVID-19 Patients* and in support to the CHED-DOH Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2021-001 on the *Guidelines for the Gradual Reopening of Campuses of Higher Education Institutions for Limited Face-to-Face Classes During the COVID-19 Pandemic*, please be informed of the following allied health programs with issued CHED Memorandum Order (CMO) for limited face-to-face classes:

1. CMO No. 2, series of 2021 on the Guidelines on the Conduct of Clinical Internship of **Speech Language Pathology** Students During Pandemic Period
2. CMO No. 3, series of 2021 on the Guidelines on the Conduct of Preclinical Courses and Clinical **Dentistry** Courses During the Pandemic Period
3. CMO No. 4, series of 2021 on the Guidelines on the Conduct of Clinical Internship of Bachelor of Science in **Respiratory Therapy** Interns During Pandemic Period
4. CMO No. 5, series 2021 on the Guidelines on the Conduct of Experiential **Pharmacy** Practice of Pharmacy Students During Pandemic Period
5. CMO No. 12, series 2021 on the Guidelines on the Conduct of Clinical Education of **Radiologic Technology** Students During the Pandemic Period

The above-mentioned programs are now included in the allowable programs for limited face-to-face classes in addition to the prioritized programs namely, (1) Medicine, (2) Nursing,


(3) Medical Technology/Medical Laboratory Science, (4) Physical Therapy, (5) Midwifery, and (6) Public Health.

The subjects or courses allowed for face-to-face delivery are delimited to specialized laboratory courses and/or hospital-based clinical clerkship/internship/practicum as stated in the guidelines per program.

The application process stipulated in the CHED-DOH JMC No. 2021-001 shall apply.
