I. CALL TO ORDER

There being a quorum, the meeting was called to order at 11:45 AM with BAC Vice-Chair- Dir. Luisa S. Valencia, presiding.

II. INTRODUCTION OF BIDDERS/REPRESENTATIVES/ BAC/TWG-OGS/ OBSERVER

MS. Violeta B. Galo, Head of the BAC Secretariat presented the bidders/representatives who attended the meeting. She also introduced the BAC members, TWG- INFRA members, BAC Secretariat, COA representative and Observers who were present during the meeting.

Nine (9) prospective bidders browsed the opportunity as per Document Request List at the website of the PhilGEPs (www.philgeps.net) namely: (a) MC Taguba Construction, (b) First R&J Builders Phils. Corp., (c) NGP Construction, (d) EB Matias Construction and Trading, (e) Silvergrace Construction and Construction Supply, (f) Reygem Builders, (g) Deus Inprimis Events Consultancy Services, (h) Supreme ABF Construction and Construction Supply Co. Inc. and (i) Thaumaturgy Trade Philippines. However, only to (2) Supreme ABF Construction and Construction Supply Co. Inc. and Thaumaturgy Trade Philippines availed of the bidding documents and submitted their technical and financial bid envelopes including the Financial envelope.

III. OVERVIEW OF THE PROJECT

Engr. Fernandita Calimlim, Head of the Technical Working Group for Infrastructure upon the instruction of the presiding officer, presented the overview of the project. She gave emphasis on important features of the Construction of Proposed 3rd Floor with Roofing of CHEDRO VI Building.

IV. OPENING OF THE FIRST ENVELOPE (ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS/, EXAMINATION OF ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS AND THE TECHNICAL PROPOSAL, EXAMINATION AND DETERMINATION OF RESPONSIVENESS AND DECLARATION OF ELIGIBLE/INELIGIBLE BIDDERS

Upon the instruction of the presiding officer, the members of the Technical Working Group for Infrastructure (TWG-INFRA) opened the **first envelope** which contained the eligibility documents and the technical bid proposal.

The bidder's envelopes were opened and the name/label was read. The documents inside the envelopes were marked "**original copy**" and then forwarded to the members of the Bids and Awards Committee for affixing of their initials in each page, while the documents inside the envelopes marked "**copy 1**" were used as reference by the members of the TWG-INFRA for eligibility checking and evaluation purposes and the last set of documents marked "**copy 2**" was retained by the BAC Secretariat for safekeeping and custody.

Upon careful checking of the eligibility documents, the members of the TWG-INFRA reported to the Bids and Awards Committee the result of their evaluation, as follows;

The Bids and Awards Committee, upon the recommendation of the TWG-INFRA, declared the bids submitted by Supreme ABF Construction and Construction Supply Co. Inc. and Thaumaturgy Trade Philippines "**ineligible**" for failure to comply with the following eligibility and technical requirements of the bidding:

- i. **Thaumaturgy Trade Philippines** - (a) Stated in **Section 1- Invitation to Bid**. No similar contract with the project being bid and list of its ongoing projects as required in Sec I- Invitation to Bid. (b) No list of equipment units, which are either owned or leased which should be supported by the certification of the availability of these equipment for the duration of the project as part of eligibility requirements under **Class B documents**.
- ii. **Supreme ABF Construction and Construction Supply Co. Inc.-** The two (2) sworn Secretary's Certificate suited were inconsistent and with conflicting dates of approval and notarization.


V. REACTION FROM THE TWG-INFRA AND BAC

The Bids and Awards Committee, upon the recommendation of the TWG-INFRA, informed the representatives from Supreme ABF Construction and Construction Supply Co. Inc. and Thaumaturgy Trade Philippines of the "**failure of bidding**" due to non-compliance with the eligibility /technical requirements of the Revised IRR of RA 9184. The concerned bidders acknowledged the result of the eligibility and technical evaluation.


VI. ADJOURNMENT
