I. CALL TO ORDER

There being a quorum, the meeting was called to order at 10.20 A.M., with BAC Vice Chair- Dir. Luisa S. Valencia, presiding.

II. INTRODUCTION OF BIDDERS/REPRESENTATIVES/ BAC/TWG-OGS/OBSERVER

Ms. Violeta B. Galo, Head of the BAC Secretariat presented the bidder who attended the meeting. She introduced the BAC members, TWG-OGS members, BAC Secretariat, end-users, observer and COA representative who were present during the meeting.

She also mentioned Canadian Bureau for International Education (CBIE) as the only company who browsed the advertisement at the website of the PhilGEPS (www.philgeps.net) per attached Document Request Lis.

III. OVERVIEW OF THE PROJECT

Engr. Edgar C. Cepe, Head of the Technical Working Group for Other Goods and Services (TWG-OGS), upon the instruction of the Presiding Officer, presented the overview of the project. He gave emphasis on the salient provisions /important features of the "Procurement of Service Provider for the Implementation of Higher Education in Canada for K to 12" with an Approved Budget of the Contract (ABC) amounting to Php 63,883,830.00

IV. OPENING OF THE FIRST ENVELOPE (ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS/, EXAMINATION OF ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTS AND THE TECHNICAL PROPOSAL, EXAMINATION AND DETERMINATION OF RESPONSIVENESS AND DECLARATION OF ELIGIBLE/INELIGIBLE BIDDERS

Upon the instruction of the Presiding Officer, the members of the Technical Working Group for Other Goods and Services (TWG-OGS) opened the **first envelope** which contained the eligibility documents and the technical bid proposal.

The bidder's envelope were opened and the name/label was read. The documents inside the envelope were marked "**original copy**" and these were forwarded to the members of the Bids and Awards Committee for affixing of their initials in each page. The documents inside the envelope marked "**copy 1**" were used as reference by the members of the TWG-OGS for eligibility checking and evaluation purposes and the last set of documents marked "**copy 2**" was retained by the BAC Secretariat for safekeeping and custody.

Upon careful checking of the eligibility documents, the members of the TWG-OGS reported to the Bids and Awards Committee the result of their evaluation, as follows;

The Bids and Awards Committee, upon the recommendation of the TWG-OGS, declared the bid submitted by Canadian Bureau of International Education (CBIE) as "eligible" and "passed" the technical requirements of the bidding.

V. OPENING OF THE SECOND ENVELOPE (FINANCIAL PROPOSAL), EXAMINATION OF FINANCIAL PROPOSAL AND DETERMINATION OF RESPONSIVENESS AND READING OF FINANCIAL PROPOSAL AND THE APPROVED BUDGET FOR THE CONTRACT (ABC)

Upon instruction from the BAC, the TWG-OGS opened the second envelope containing the financial bid proposals by Canadian Bureau of International Education (CBIE).

Hereunder is the Abstract of Bids on the evaluation of the second envelope relative to the conduct of public bidding on the Canadian Bureau of International Education (CBIE), as follows:

VI. TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP FOR OTHER GOODS AND SERVICES RECOMMENDATION

The financial bid of Canadian Bureau of International Education (CBIE) which was earlier declared "eligible" and passed the technical evaluation was within the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC). The TWG-OGS recommended to the BAC, the conduct of further evaluation and to make the recommendation within seven (7) days from the receipt of proposals. The BAC upon deliberation approved said recommendation on the basis of Section 32.4 of the Revised IRR of RA 9184 which states that the "evaluation process for the procurement of goods and infrastructure projects shall be completed within seven (7) calendar days from the deadline for receipt of proposals.

VII. COMMENTS/REACTION FROM THE BAC AND THE BIDDERS

The Bids and Awards Committee, upon the recommendation of the TWG-OGS, informed the representatives of Canadian Bureau of International Education (CBIE) on the conduct of further technical and financial evaluation and to complete the evaluation within seven (7) days from receipt of the proposal. Said information was acknowledged by the bidder's representatives,




