SUBJECT : SUBMISSION OF SUC LAND USE DEVELOPMENT AND
INFRASTRUCTURE PLAN (LUDIP)

DATE : 9 DECEMBER 2021

Sec. 3 of R.A. No. 11396 or the SUC LUDIP Law requires all SUCs to submit their LUDIP within two years of the enactment of the said law.

CHED Office of Institutional Quality Assurance and Governance (OIQAG) has been asking all SUCs to submit these documents since 2020 with limited compliance.

In this regard, all SUCs are required to submit to the CHED OIQAG their respective LUDIPs by 21 December 2021.

These documents shall be submitted to the Office of the President (OP) and the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) for compliance audit and as input for higher education resource allocation management.

SUCs which fail to submit their LUDIP or any documents used for planning the utilization of their respective land assets shall be deemed non-compliant with the requirements of R.A. No. 11396 and the responsible officials subjected to the appropriate administrative action. As provided under R.A. No. 11396, future infrastructure projects of SUCs shall be approved and implemented based on their submitted and approved LUDIPs.
